

MATERIAL SUPPLIER LIST

Most suppliers are open on Saturdays, but you should call to verify hours and if appointments are recommended. If you are hoping to hand select slabs this will require supplier to move material, recommend you make an appointment for this (to ensure additional staff/equipment is available). As with ANY product, whether looking at a picture or a small sample of your potential selection, it is **HIGHLY** recommended that you visit the supplier of your selected choice, to verify its overall pattern/color expectations are being met. Samples only represent a small portion of the slab and may not reflect its complete pattern or color variations.

IMPORTANT ** Suppliers will only hold your selected material anywhere from 7 to 30 days (please check with their policies) and will not notify us or you that product has been released after time period has expired. Suppliers will no longer hold material while you wait for a new shipment to come in. They are in the business of selling slabs and cannot bring in new shipments until room is made by selling existing inventories. MB Marble is not responsible for the policies of our suppliers. You should **NOT** hold material IF your job is not expected to start (Interior) within this period, it is recommended that you wait to select your actual material during the dry wall phase of construction. Check with suppliers regarding their individual policies. Please note that a product known by one supplier may be called something else at another supply house (i.e.: Viara at Capco is known as Indian Parana at Arizona Tile), lack of name recognition does not mean Supplier may not carry it.

NATURAL STONE- is a product of nature. The natural color, texture and veining may vary in each slab and from one area of the slab to another within the same piece. All stones have natural variations, coloration, fissures, veins & pits, some more noticeable than others, especially when laying horizontal. MB is not responsible for these variations. In some cases, the very thing that makes the stone beautiful, can be the very thing that can create "issues". Some tend to think unusual markings in the stone as imperfections, we need to remember that "Mother Nature" created these materials... they ARE as "nature" intended. In your (or your customers) excitement and with the overwhelming stone/color selections, you may/can miss some important details in the stone. Slab quarries may "fill" with various products (resin, crushed stone, epoxy) the areas in the slab that have surface chips, cracks or split veins. MB is not responsible for these variations or issues. Also, though there can be exceptions- NO material is impervious to staining or scratching, even sealed. Softer stones (light colored granites, limestones, travertines, marbles, etc.), Honed or Textured materials, are more porous and prone to staining (even sealed). Certain products can stain (darken) or etch even sealed stone. MB Marble is not responsible for this occurrence.

Regarding UNPOLISHED (Leathered, Brushed, Satin, Caressed, Honed, etc.) MATERIAL SURFACES. A sample of your material choice with your choice of finish may not be available. Once customer commits to the "textured/unpolished" surface it will be installed "as is". Though there are exceptions, the nature of this process is to make the material look used/aged/distressed/un-polished and/or hide potential imperfections/issues. The degree/depth/visible "swirl" marks created by this process is dependent of the material itself. MB Marble is not responsible for the material surface. Natural stone will be cleaned & sealed but NO re-fill or touch up will be done to surface. IF material does not come pre-textured from the supplier, there will be an additional charge to have this done, price depends on "finish" selected. This process may add weeks (+/-) to existing schedule. Changing a Quartz surface will void Manufacturer's warranty.

MANMADE/QUARTZ MATERIALS For Maintenance & Warranty information, please refer to the manufacturer's website. Based on different recommended requirements of the various manufacturers, MB Marble will not seal/protect selected material. Based on different recommended requirements of the various manufacturers and surface finishes, it is **HIGHLY** recommended you visit the manufacturer's website for the care and maintenance of their product. MB Marble will not seal/protect selected material, as (in most cases) this will void the manufacturer's warranty. Most quartz suppliers will offer you, not only a wide range of colors, but of finishes as well; including polished, honed, satin, and brushed. Just as each finish has a different look; it also has slightly different characteristics. **IMPORTANT!** The unpolished finishes require slightly more maintenance than the polished finishes. Since the unpolished finish actually creates more visible surface area to the material it has the potential to show more signs of living from daily use. Possible marks from metal cookware or utensils; fingerprints, food and beverages, and other items placed on, or moved across the countertop, may be visible on the surface. Most marks can be easily removed with a cloth or sponge; or by using household cleaners such as a cleaning eraser or carefully scrubbing with a sponge and a non-abrasive cleaner such as Soft Scrub Advanced Cleaner®. Over time the unpolished finish will develop character and a patina unique to each customer. Unpolished finishes can be cleaned using the same products and methods as other finishes, please see go to your selected manufacturers website for their care and maintenance guide. The warranty issued by the Manufacturer covers manufacturing defects; however, the temporary marks that commonly occur on unpolished finishes, are inherent to the material, and are not covered under the terms of their warranty. It is the responsibility of the end user to maintain the selected material.
